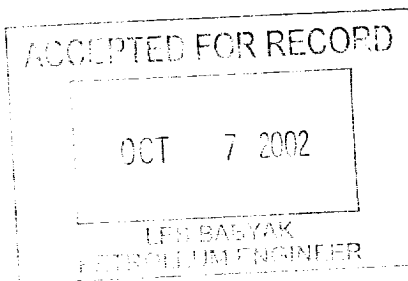

At approximately 6:00 AM on October 2, 2002 Yates employee, Leroy Richardson sustained shoulder and rib injuries while performing his usual duties at the Brannigan ANF Federal #1 (NWNW of Section 6-T22S-R24E). He was transported to a Lubbock hospital and is expected to be released around October 4, 2002.

The accident resulted from equipment failure at the adjacent compressor facility. The cause of the equipment failure is currently being investigated.
