Drilling operations on subject well have been suspended since June 16, 1965 pending clarification of lease title. It now is planned to resume operations approximately January 7, 1969. Prior to temporary abandonment, 8-5/8-inch casing was cemented at the total depth of 533 feet with 175% of calculated annular volume. Cement did not circulate. Subsequent temperature survey indicated annular cement top at 325 feet. Inasmuch as no water was logged in the hole below a depth of 85 feet, it is planned to perforate the 8-5/8-inch casing with two holes at approximately 300 feet, establish circulation, and fill annulus with cement to surface before further drilling is undertaken.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
