M. P. PERATOR, DIED MEXICO. Upon Completion of the well as a Producer, Purpose of this letter, Oryx Energy Company hereby agrees to indemnify Chevron from all liability that may arise as a result of Oryx Energy's operations on Section 5, T22S, R23E, Eddy County, NM. See "Indemnification Agreement" attached.
