THIS CHANGE WILL PROVIDE AN ACCEPTABLE SEAT FOR A TUBING ANCHOR TO BE SET IF THE WELL IS PRODUCED BEFORE BEING USED FOR INJECTION. ALSO, THE WEIGHT OF THE FIBERGLASS LINER WILL BE 5.41#. EXCEPT FOR THESE CHANGES, PREVIOUSLY APPROVED CSG. PLAN WILL REMAIN THE SAME.
