Form C-101, Application for Permit to Drill, was approved March 6, 1978 to drill the City of Carlsbad #1 as an Undesignated Delaware test to a proposed depth of 2600 feet. This depth tested the Delaware Sand productive in the Herradura Sand Pool. This sand was penetrated at a depth of 2519 feet and found to be dry.

It is proposed to continue drilling to a Delaware Sand between 3200 - 3300 feet that is productive in the Old Indian Draw Pool. The proposed depth is amended to 3300 feet.
