MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

- A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a road map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. From the intersection of New Mexico highways 31 and 128, go southwest on highway 31 for 0.5 mile and turn southeast through a cattle guard onto a graded road. Follow this road approximately 0.4 mile, crossing the railroad at 0.2 mile. The proposed well location is approximately 300 feet west of this point.
- B. Exhibit "B" is a plat showing existing roads within a onemile radius of the well site and the planned access road. Existing roads and the planned new road are color coded.
- C. Any repairs to existing roads do not appear necessary at the present time.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

- A. Length and Width: The new road will be 12 feet wide and approximately 200 feet long. This new road is labled and color coded red on Exhibit "B". The center line of the proposed new road, from the beginning to the well site, has been staked and flagged with the stakes being visible from any one to the next.
- B. <u>Surfacing Material</u>: Six inches of caliche, watered, compacted and graded.
- C. Maximum Grade: One percent.
- D. Turnouts: None required.
