

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN
Yates Petroleum Corporation
Martha "AIK" Federal #1
330'FSL and 430'FEL

Eddy County, New Mexico

This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operations.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

Exhibit A is a portion of BLM map showing the well and roads in the vicinity of the proposed location. The proposed wellsite is located approximately 35 miles northeast of Loving, New Mexico, and the access route to the location is indicated in red and green on Exhibit A.

DIRECTIONS:

Go southeast out of Carlsbad, New Mexico on 285 to 31. Go east on 31 to 128 (Jal Hwy). Go approximately 16 miles to Red Road (County Road 802). Turn north and go approximately 9 miles on the pavement. Will be a Lea County 29 sign. Go north on caliche road crossing another paved road. Continue north for approximately 1 1/4 mile. New access will start here and go west to the southeast corner of pad. Yates wishes to apply for an existing road right-of-way from this well south to the pavement approximately 1.1 miles.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD

- A. The proposed new access will be approximately 20' in length from point of origin to the southeast edge of the drilling pad. The road will lie in an east to west direction.
- B. The new road will be 14 feet in width (driving surface) and will be adequately drained to control runoff and soil erosion.
- C. The new road will be bladed with drainage on both sides. No traffic turnout will be built.
- D. The route of the road is visible.
