

On 6-8-93, we perforated the Lower Brushy Canyon from 8036' - 8194'(total holes = 24). The next day, we acidized the perfs with 1500 gals 7 1/2% NEFE HCl acid + ball sealers. On 6-11-93, we fraced the new perfs via 5 1/2" casing with 59,000 gals gelled 2% KCl water + 152,000 lbs 16/30 Ottawa sand + 56,000 lbs 16/30 resin coated sand. The well was flowed back immediately for forced closure. Currently, we are recovering the load and testing the well. A test will be submitted as soon as possible.
