Spudded a 26" hole with rat hole machine at 2:45 PM 10-24-94. Set 40' of 20" conductor pipe. Cemented to surface. NOTE: Notified BLM Answering Service of spud. Resumed drilling a 17-1/2" hole at 9:45 AM 10-26-94 with rotary tools.

TD 700'. Ran 16 joints of 13-3/8" 48# H-40 ST&C (704.97') of casing set at 700'. 1-Texas Pattern notched guide shoe set at 700'. Float collar set at 657.35'. Cemented with 350 sacks Pacesetter Lite C, 1/4#/sack celloseal and 3% CaCl<sub>2</sub> (yield 2.01, weight 12.4). Tailed in with 250 sacks "C" 2% CaCl<sub>2</sub> (yield 1.34, weight 14.8). PD 4:15 PM 10-26-94. Bumped plug to 700 psi, OK. Circulated 167 sacks. WOC. Drilled out at 2:15 PM 10-27-94. WOC 22 hours. Nipped up and tested BOP to 1000#, OK. Reduced hole to 11". Resumed drilling.
