Gentlemen:

On April 14, 1997 your office received an Administrative Application for Unorthodox Oil Well Location and Simultaneous Dedication for the Lentini '1' Federal #16. Since that time, Chevron has decided to move the wellbore up-dip in order to minimize the completion risk associated with the proposed new drill.
