Gentlemen:

The subject well was apparently plugged up to 145 feet and from that point was converted into a water well. Our District Supervisor, Mr. M. L. Armstrong, has written to you stating that an Affidavit of Responsibility for Conversion to Water Well must be executed by the landowner. We have received no reply from you regarding this matter.

If we do not receive an executed Affidavit of Responsibility for Conversion to a Water Well within thirty days, we will demand that the surety company, Travelers Indemnity, plug this well to the surface. We are enclosing copies of the Affidavit of Responsibility which must be filed with this Commission.
