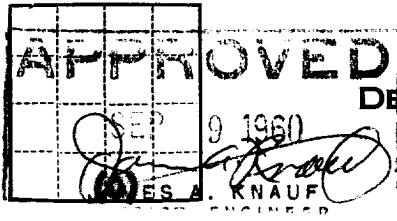

DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill 12 1/4 surface hole and set 6 5/8" surface casing to 310', and cement w/ sufficient cement to fill casing annulus. Drill 7 7/8" hole to a depth of 1,300' approximately or through the Delaware Sand. Set 6 1/8" casing through pay zone. Perforate in the Delaware Sand and fracture perforated interval with 1,000 gals. refined oil and 1000' sand. Shut well in for production. Anticipated yield date 9-15-60. Anticipated formation tops: Delaware Line - 130 Schram Delaware Sand - 220 Schram
