DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill 12-1/4" hole and set approximately 330' 8-5/8" surface casing and cement with sufficient cement to circulate to the surface. Drill 7-7/8" hole to top of Delaware Sand and cement 5-1/2" casing in hole with sufficient cement to fill 600' of annulus. Drill in with cable tools. Fracture Delaware Sand with 1000 gals. refined oil and 1000# sand. Shut well in. Anticipated spud date 5/13/61. Anticipated formation tops:

Delaware Lime -113' subsea
Delaware Sand -165' subsea
