We are returning herewith approved Form C-104 & C-110 for the above mentioned well, with the notation on form C-104 that the approval is for clearing storage of distillate accumulated while testing.

It will be necessary for you to write a letter to proration manager, Box 2045, Hobbs, New Mexico, setting forth the amount of such storage, so that he can issue a supplement to the proration schedule, authorizing the moving of the distillate.

I should also like to mention that we are in need of Form C-102 setting out your projected depth for your Julia Beeman, et al. # 1 well in section 2-24S-28E. The original Form C-101 Notice of Intention to Drill was approved for a 7,000 ft. test, and our latest scout report indicates the well drilling at 7794 ft.
