November 21, 1957 - Perforated production casing from 2105' to 2115' with 3 legs
not back tracked with 2000 gals of Petro-Tel and 3000 # of sand.
November 25-26, 1957 - Shipped well for production test at 49 bbls. of 40° API
crude/24 hours plus 4 bbls of water.
November 28, 1957 - Set pumping unit.
December 2-3, 1957 - Pumped well for production test at 42 3/4 bbls of 40° API
crude plus 2 1/4 bbls. of water.
