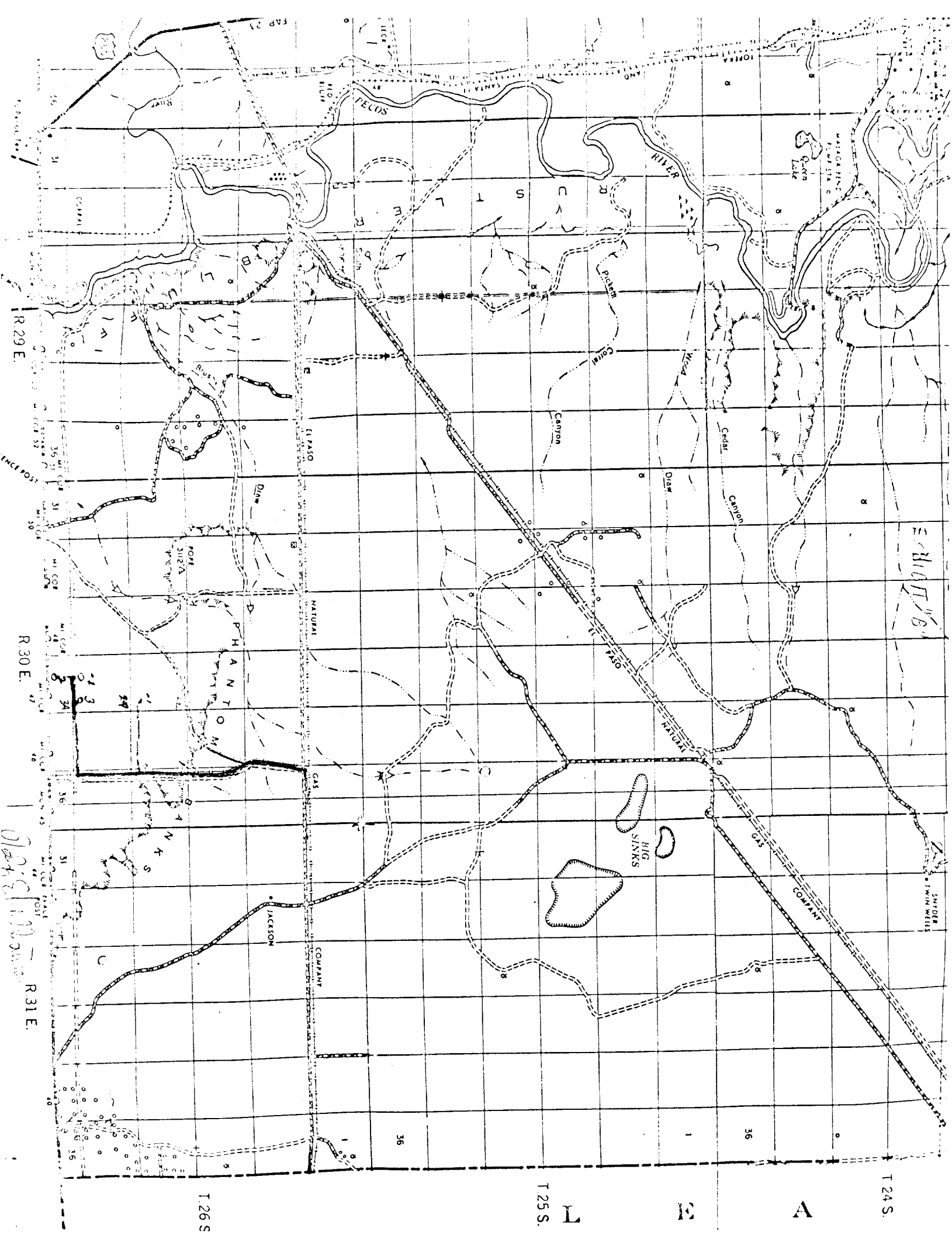

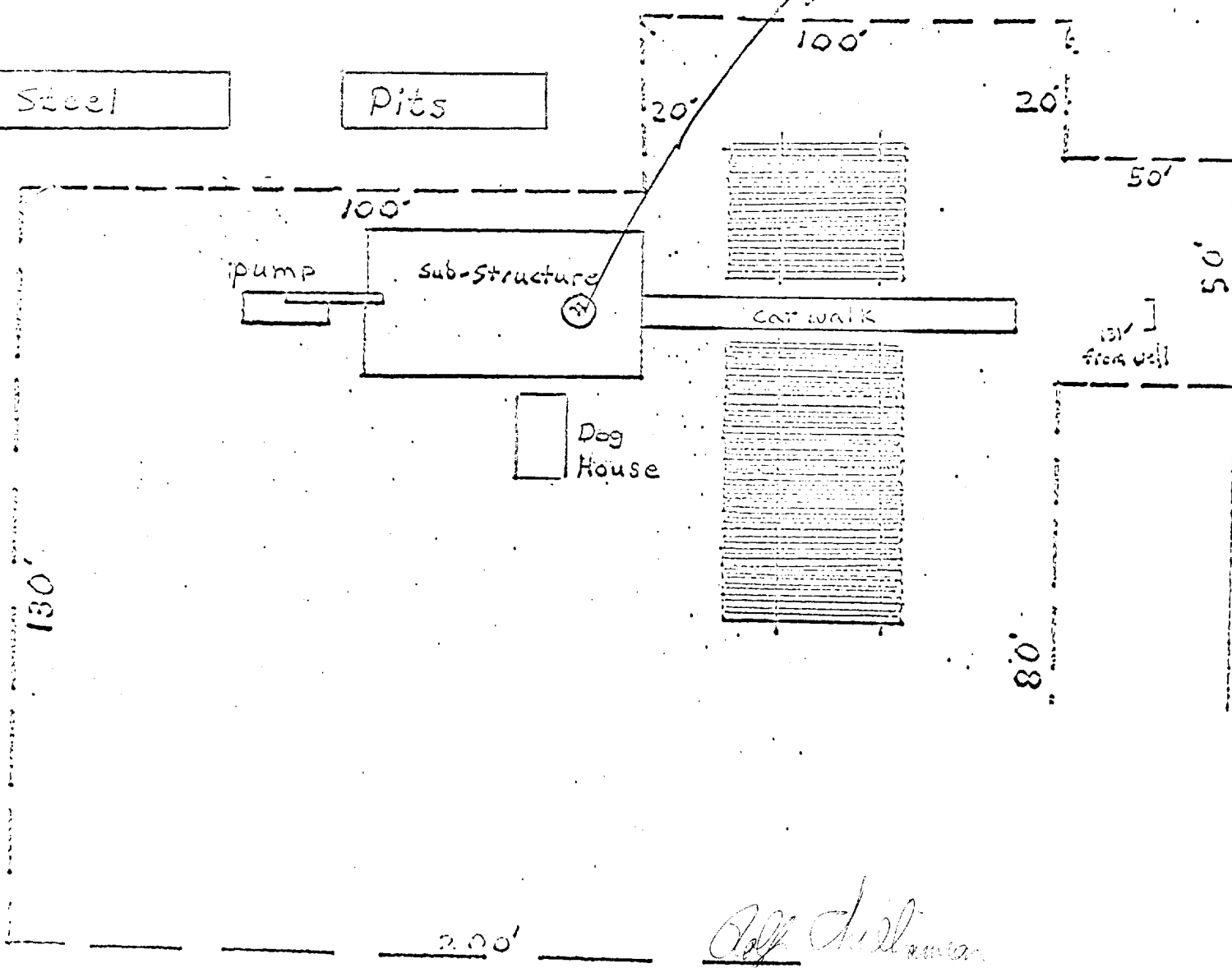
Rig Plot and Rig Layout

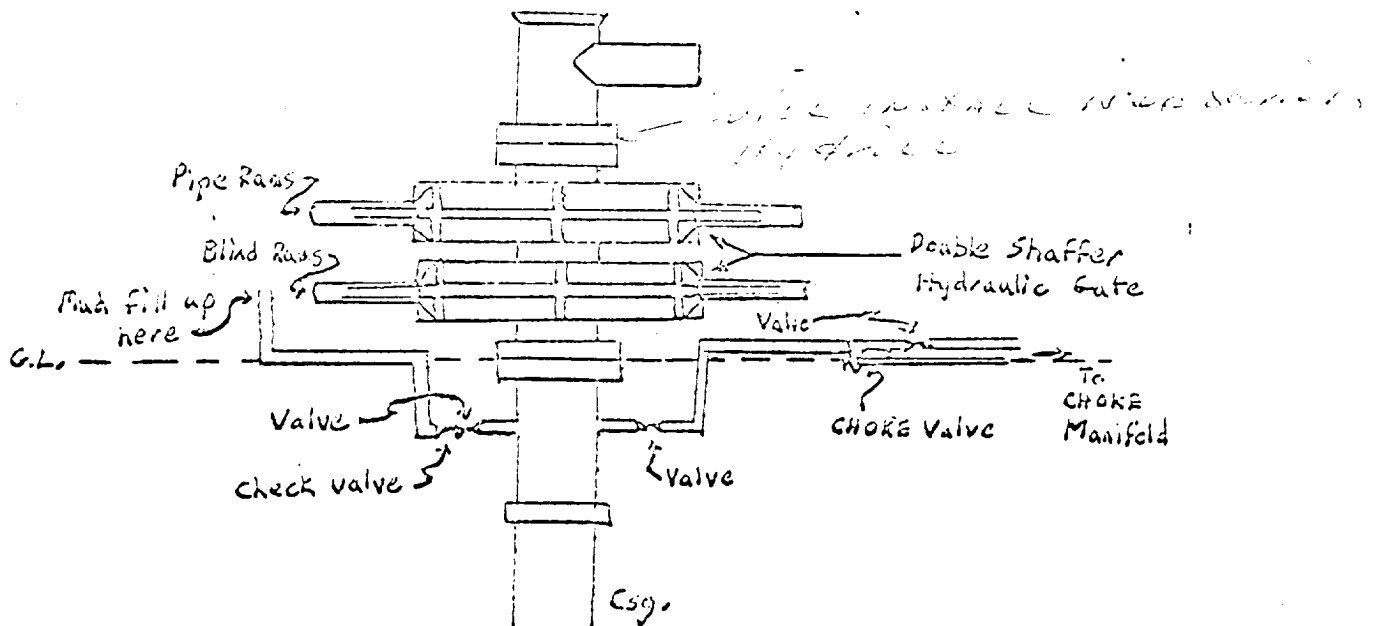
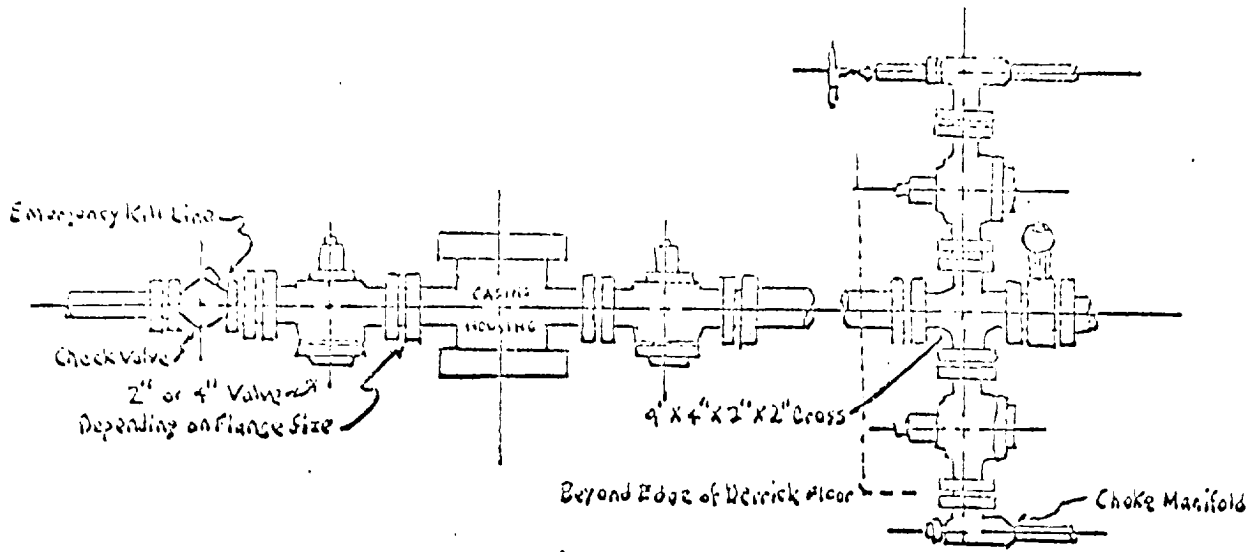
