12-22-75: Ran GR-CCL log prior to setting 5 1/2" casing with Gearhart-Owens Isolation Tool. Top packer set at 3971-73' - bottom packer set at 3997-99'. Sliding sleeves with eight (8) 3/4" ports at 3975' and 3995'.

12-31-75: Opened sliding sleeves. Set packer at 3981', circulated through the two sleeves and washed formation with 300 gallons acid.

1-1-76 : Reset packer at 3943' and began swab testing.

1-3-76 : Re-acidized with 1500 gals 7 1/2% mud acid and began swab testing.

1-5-76 : Re-acidized with 5000 gals 15% HCl.

1-6-76 : Began swab testing.

1-16-76 : Installed pumping equipment and began testing. Pumped water with a trace of oil.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
