Mr. Clements,

This is in reply to your letter of May 20, 1983, concerning the above captioned well.

We continued testing the well through mid May, evaluating the various sets of Delaware formation perforations. We concluded after evaluating these tests, that although the well was producing four to five barrels of oil a day and twenty to twenty-five barrels of water a day, that the well would be more productive if completed in an upper Delaware zone. Thus no completion reports and related and required reports have been filed. This completion in the upper zone will require that plugs are set, and pipe is pulled (see attached C103). I visited with Mike Williams as to our plans for this procedure.
