On 11/12/92, the BLM approved our APD to drill this well at 1650' FSL & 330' FWL. Subsequently, we have moved the location 660' to the east and re-staked the well. Per our conversation with Tony Herrell and Shannon Shaw on 1/25/93, we are submitting this sundry notice to request approval for the new location. Enclosed are the plat, topo map and road map depicting the new surface location. An archaeological survey will be forwarded to your office by Dr. Haskell of NMAS. Dan Talley, our field foreman in Artesia has consulted with Barry Hunt concerning this new location.

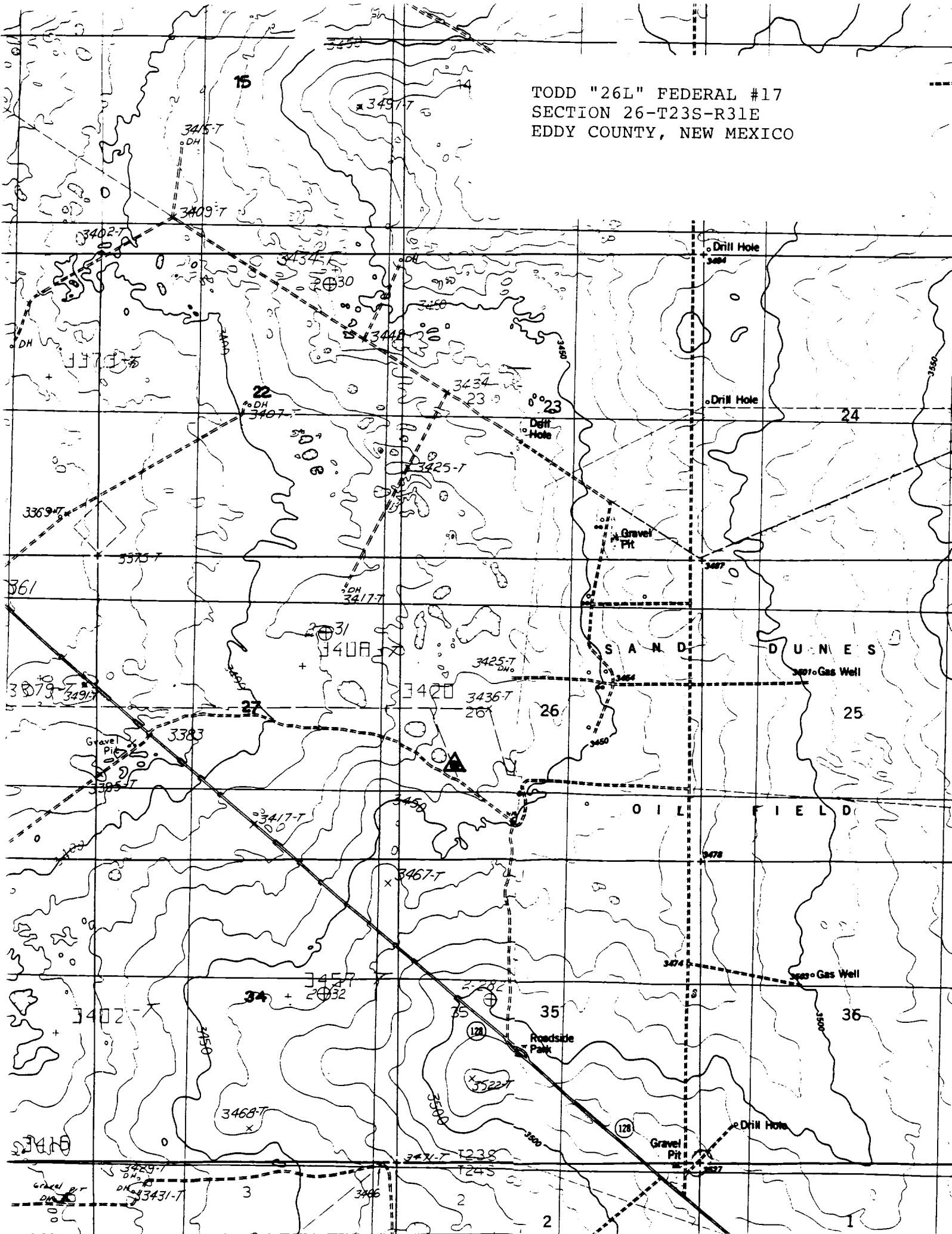

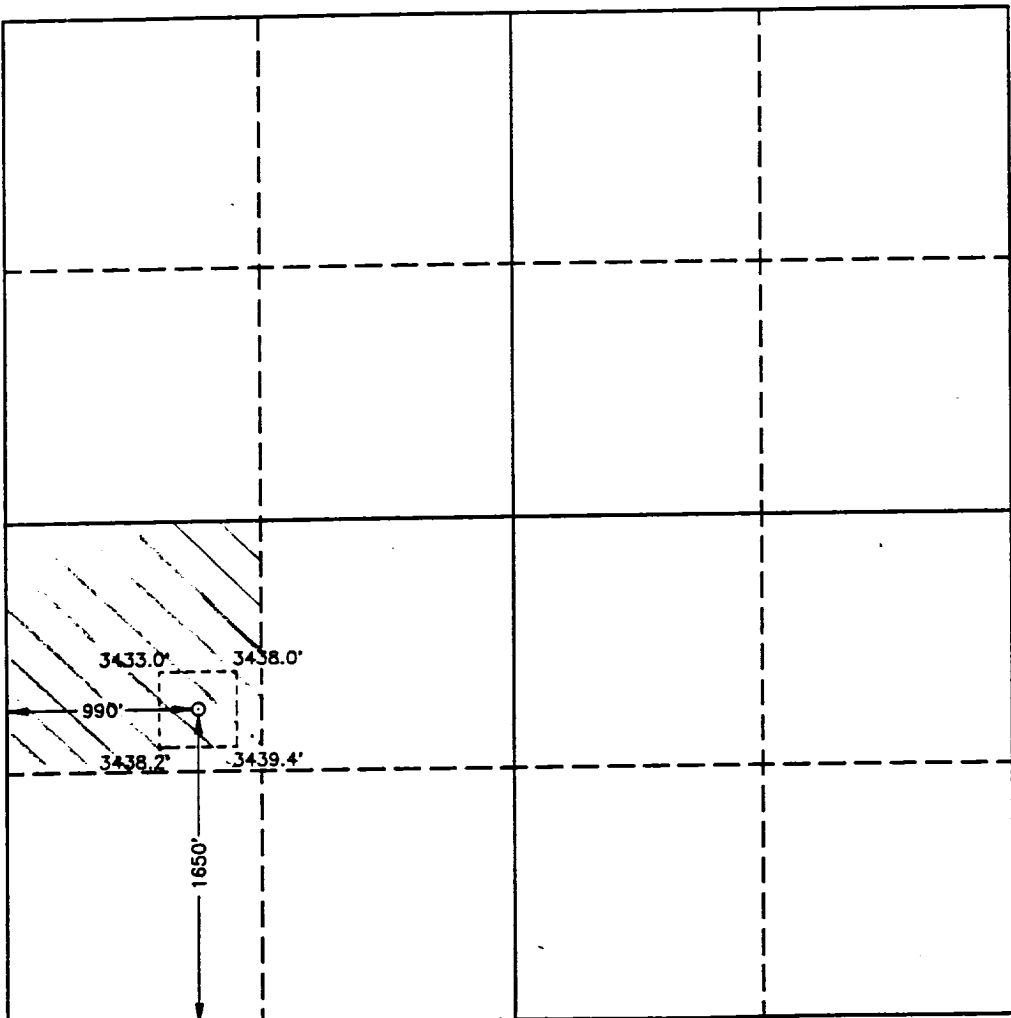
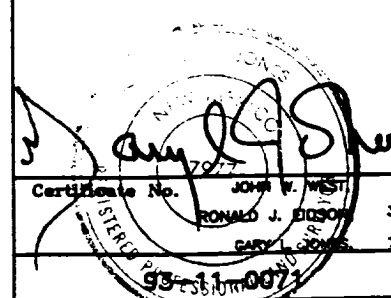
