
Gentlemen:

As a follow-up to Enron's filing of the Form C-101 (Application for Permit to Drill) and C-102 (Well Location and Acreage Dedication) forms for the referenced well, enclosed please find copies of certified-return receipts and letters notifying the potash operators who hold potash leases within a radius of one mile of the proposed well of Enron's intent to drill. For your reference we have attached a plat depicting the potash leasehold in the nine sections around the proposed well.
