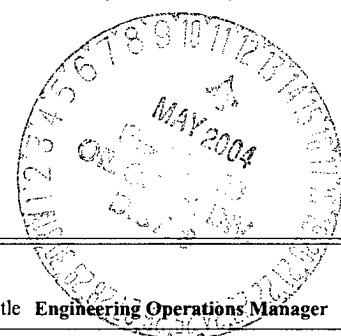

 5. If not economical well will be plugged back to the Pictured Cliffs and Fruitland Coal formations.
