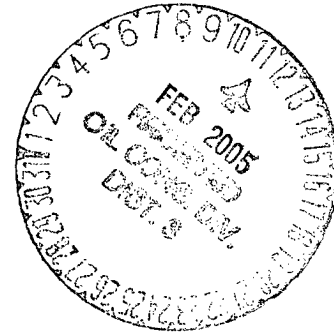

Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the **No. 2G Jackson** well, located **2500' FSL** and **785' FEL, Section 18, T31N, R12W San Juan County, New Mexico**. This APD was approved on **August 7, 2002** with an expiration date of **August 7, 2003**. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location.
