DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill the above well to approximately 1300 feet or to the top of the Pictured Cliffs formation. Rotary tools will be used to total depth. Casing will be set on top of pay. Pay will be shot with 200 and hole cleaned out with rotary tools.

The following casing program is proposed:

Size	Depth	Amount	Remarks
9-5/8"	300	300	175% of calculated amount to circulate.
5-1/2"	1300	100	150% of calculated amount to fill 600' above shoe.
