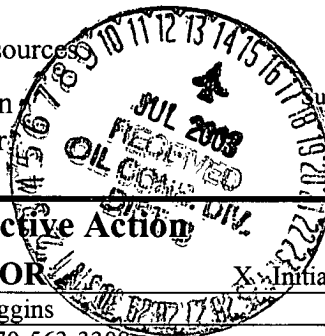

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Triple S Trucking was contracted to remove the drilling mud from the reserve pit on location. During this process it was believed that a large tear was left in the pit liner. Williams Production responded to the problem by notifying the OCD and the BLM. Williams received permission to relocate the contents of the pit to the Rosa 215A location. Upon arriving on site to empty the pit, a close examination of the pit was made. It was discovered that the tear was not as significant as earlier believed and that it did not pose a threat of spills or leaks. No product in any amount was released from the pit. It has been determined that no remedial action is necessary. The requirement for this report is a direct result of the verbal report.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
