All,

Attached are the lab results of the stockpiled soil sampling. The results are non-detect for hydrocarbons and BTEX. The results for chlorides range from 812 ppm to 1,930 ppm. Due to the elevated chloride levels, the soil from these stockpiles could be used in areas where vegetation is not desired, i.e. roadways, and where groundwater is greater than 50 feet in depth and greater than 300' from any sensitive receptors.

Vanessa,

There is approximately 12,000 cubic yards of soil stockpiled. Based on the sampling interval requested below, this would tally up to 120 samples and would take approximately 2 weeks to complete sampling alone.

Attached are the results of the sampling performed in August of 2005. The piles were sampled individually, for piles 5-8 and combined piles for piles 1&2 and 3&4. Please note, none of the results exceeded 100 ppm, even including MRO hydrocarbons. With continued degradation from the composting, I would assume the hydrocarbon levels to be even lower given the time lapsed.

I propose to sample piles 1, 2, 3 and 4 in halves, each half with a 5 point composite and piles 5-8 as thirds, with each third as a composite.

Please let me know if you approve.

All,

The last communication I had on this soil stock pile was with Roger Herrera with the BLM. This was back in August. At that time the BLM – Roger was proposing that this soil be utilized in the area for covering exposed pipelines and repairing roads. It was stated that having this in the area could save wear and tear on roads by not having to truck in soils. Roger told me he was working this proposal through the BLM internally and would let me know when a final decision was made. I have not receive any final decision at this point in time from Roger.

It would be beneficial in my opinion if the BLM and the NMOCD could collaborate on this issue and then notify Steve and myself of what the final decision is on what will be required of BPX to come into compliance with both State and Federal regulations on this matter. I would be available to meet with both agencies to discuss a path forward if necessary. This stock pile is located on a plug and abandoned well pad which is my responsibilities and I have Steve available to advise and help out if needed.

In addition if someone could also confirm the seasonal restrictions for this area I would greatly appreciate it so that everyone on the email is of the same understanding on time frame to start and complete work based on the decision that is reached by the BLM on what they want to happen with this soil.

Randy, Cory and Vanessa,

BPX is working to remove the treated soil stockpiles from the subject site. Based on a conversation I had with Vanessa on Thursday 11/29, the NMOCD will likely be seeking additional samples from the stockpiles to ensure the piles are of satisfactory standing prior to granting closure. Vanessa is currently out of the office, scheduled to return 12/10. I will await direction from the NMOCD prior to proceeding. BPX is currently collecting resources and pricing to expedite executing this sampling.

Currently, Enterprise Products plans to use this material for padding and covering of their lines in the area. However, due to seasonal closures in the area, EPROD will not be able to remove the soil until spring of 2019. I understood that the BLM had facilitated the use of this material based on our conversations in May of 2018. I apologize as I had not heard any movement since.
