Upon discovery, the valve was fully opened and a small obstruction was removed from in between the seat and trim of the water dump valve. The leak stopped once the obstruction was removed. The loss of gas was calculated over a seven (7) day period.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **All natural gas was vented to the atmosphere.**
