
Energen Resources recently finished completion operations on the subject well. In accordance to the approved C-103, the supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the NMOCD shall determine the proper production allocation.

Due to completion complications, this well was completed in the Dakota, and then had significant wellwork before completing in the Mesaverde. A composite bridge plug was set below the Mesaverde to isolate the Dakota during stimulation of the Mesaverde. After completion of the Mesaverde, the well was tested through a 1/4" choke for 2 hours at a stabilized rate of 85 mcf/d. The composite plug was then drilled out and a packer was run to flow test the Dakota through a 3/8" choke for several hours at a stabilized rate of 170 mcf/d. Both zones produced a trace of oil. The following allocation is recommended:

	<u>Gas</u>	<u>Oil</u>
Blanco-Mesaverde	34%	50%
Basin Dakota	66%	50%
