DETAILS OF WORK

Well drilled to a total depth of 6920', plugged back to 6700' with 88 sacks of cement. 7" casing set at 6648' R.T. with 108 sacks cement. Cement drilled out to 6715' and hole plugged back to 6680' with 20 sacks cement. Tubing set at 6675' R.T. Well a failure for production of oil or petroleum gas; well released to U.S. Bureau of Mines for Helium gas tests. It is now proposed to plug and abandon well as follows: Kill well with heavy mud (Recover tubing, abandon and cement casing in hole) set cement plug from bottom 6680' up into casing approx 100 feet. Fill hole with mud. Set cement plug of 10 sacks cement and regulation marker in top of surface casing.
