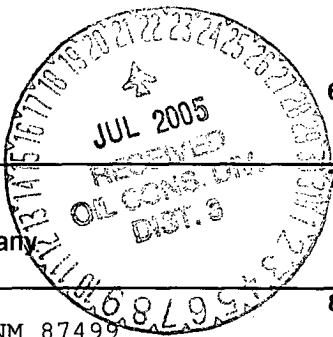

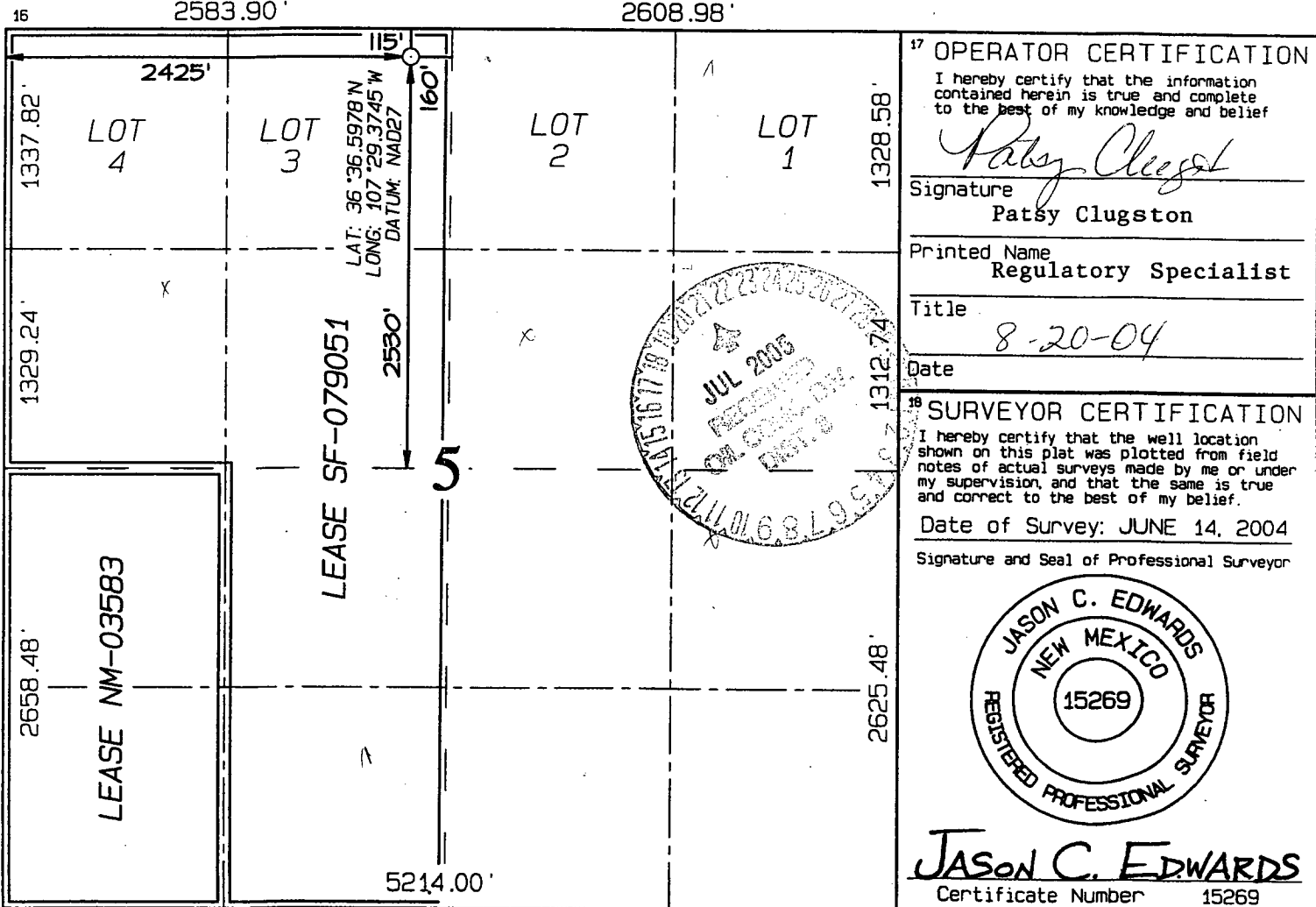

Burlington Resources anticipates closing these pits according to the Drilling / Workover Pit Closure Procedure dated August 2, 2004 on file at the NMOCD office.

Go right (Southerly) for 0.5 miles to fork in road;

Go left which is straight (Southerly) for 1.6 miles to 4-way intersection (Crow's Foot);

Go straight (South-westerly) @ 4-way intersection (Crow's Foot) for 1.4 miles to fork in road;

Go left which is straight (South-westerly) for 0.8 miles to fork in road;

Go right (North-westerly) for 0.1 miles to fork in road;
