If any surface disturbance was conducted, you must file your plans for reclamation.

Under 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of any instructions, orders, or decisions issued by the Authorized Officer. Such a request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P.O. Procedures governing appeals from the instructions, orders, or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et. Seq.

Required for this location is a 450-foot access road. This road will be built for either the Rosa 258A or the Rosa 189C; whichever is to be drilled first.

A pipeline tie of 104.6' will be required.
