Dear Mr. Walker:

BP America Production Company (hereinafter BP) was contacted in June of 2012, regarding natural gas and H2S in the groundwater around the plugged Federal B #1 location. Information including gas analysis and well history were also provided to BP indicating the groundwater contamination was likely caused by a historical casing leak from the Federal B #1 well. BP agreed with the findings and indicated they would proceed in one of two directions after having a Well Integrity Specialist/Engineer review the well. The two plans proposed were: re-entry of the P/A'd well, or drilling a treatment/monitor well. The last official correspondence regarding this well came from Buddy Shaw with BP in November of 2012. The OCD is aware Mr. Shaw is no longer with BP and has made various verbal attempts with other personnel for a plan forward and has yet to receive one.

In order to protect fresh water, you are hereby directed to submit a remediation plan within 30 days and initiate remedial activity before December 5, 2013.
