


**Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*** The well produced more than expected and the pit tank overflowed approximately 3 barrels of produced water into the bermed area.

**Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*** The produced water was all contained inside the berm around the pit tank on location. No fluids were recovered. The impacted soils inside the berm were turned over and broken up to prevent a crust from forming.
