Energen Resources finished a pay add and down hole commingling operations on the subject well, in accordance with the approved Notice of Intent.

Prior to commingling operations, the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin Mancos were producing at a stabilized rate of about 79 MCFPD and less than 1/4 BOPD. The Gavilan PC was added in September 2013. The well has stabilized at a rate of about 129 MCPD and about 2 BOPD. The following allocation is recommended (see attached production plot):
