On April 2, 2014 the Farmington Field Office, Bureau of Land Management conducted a field inspection on the Cases A 4M, 2580 FNL & 2105 FEL, Section 18, T31N. R11W, lease number SF-078095 to evaluate the success of the final reclamation for this well site. According to our records this well was plugged on August 20, 2008. Conditions of Approval (COA's) attached to the approved Notice Of Intent to Abandon required that the well location and access road be reclaimed within one year of the plugging date. The results of our inspection are as follows:
