This exception is requested for the following reasons: WPX Energy requests authorization to flare this well due to an expected spike in nitrogen content above acceptable Enterprise pipeline standards due to nearby frac activity on the NE CHACO COM #201H, NE CHACO COM #202H, and NE CHACO COM #270H. As a result, WPX Energy is anticipating that the NE CHACO COM #203H may experience crossflow. If a crossflow event on the well results in nitrogen content above Enterprise pipeline standards, flaring may begin as soon as given approval. The well would flare for up to 30 days. Pipeline quality gas should be obtained within 30 days. A gas sample will be collected upon the confirmation of crossflow and sent to a third party for a gas analysis. The results of the gas analysis will be submitted upon receipt. The well flows to Enterprise at a rate of 1775 MCF/D.
