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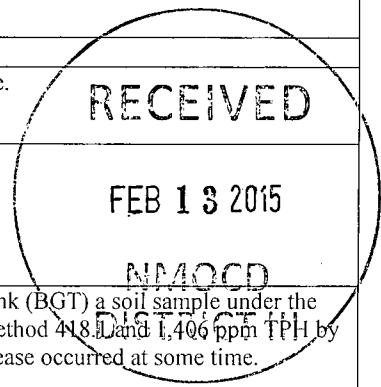

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* During construction operations to remove the below grade tank (BGT) a soil sample under the tank was taken. Visible evidence of staining or impacts was noticed and the lab analysis showed 1,380 ppm TPH by Method 418.1 and 1,406 ppm TPH by Method 8015D. Benzene was non-detect but total BTEX was 109 ppm by Method 8021. The lab results indicate a release occurred at some time.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* BP will move our remediation crew to this site in the near future to excavate and remove the impacted soil.
