- 1. Comply with all OCD, DPC and contractor safety rules and regulations. Hold safety meetings each morning.
- 2. MIRU, Check Braden head for pressure. Bleed pressure off of well if necessary.
- 3. Plug # 1- (Upper Gallup Sand 1569'-1620') RIH with 2 7/8" 6.5#, WS with mule shoe sub. Wash wellbore to TD of 1620'. Mix and Pump 19 Sks, Class B Cement @ 15.5 ppg to cover Gallup with 50'cap and 50'excess.
- 4. Plug #2-(Mancos Plug/ Surface Plug, 750'-Surface) MIRU Wireline Truck, RIH with CBL Tool, from 1500' to Surface. Shoot 3-3/8"Squeeze holes (120 Degree Phasing) at approx. 750', actual to be determined from Bond Log. MIRU Pump Truck, Pump Approx. 20 bbls Fresh Water to establish circulation through Squeeze Holes. At Successful Circulation, Mix and Bullhead 130 Sks, Class B Cement @ 15.5 ppg, for outside annulus, Mancos Surface Plug, followed with 102 Sks of Class B Cement @ 15.5 ppg from 750' to Surface. Allow well to stabilize overnight. Top Casing off with Cement if necessary.
- **5.** Cut off well 3' below ground and install P&A marker per OCD specifications. RD, cleanup MOL.
- **6.** Restore location to OCD specifications.
