Operator, Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc., set a bridge plug over the Lower Fruitland Coal (S-8) at 1,025' KB on September 13, 2005. The Middle Fruitland Coal (S-9) was perforated from 926' - 32' KB, and 995' - 1,003' KB with 4 SPF and 120 degree phasing. The perf intervals were isolated, broken down with 800 gals 15% HCl acid and swabbed back to the rig pit. Halliburton fraced the S-9 down 5-1/2" casing with 15,980 gals Delta 140 Cross-Linked Gel containing 14,700 lbs 16/30 Mesh Brady sand. The frac screened out to 4,000 psig. The Middle Fruitland Coal (S-9) is currently being pump tested. A re-frac is currently scheduled for December, 2005.
