13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to remove the packer on the dual well and commingle production from the Otero Chacra (pool 82329) and the Blanco Mesaverde (pool 72319). The production will be commingled according to Oil Conservation Division Order Number 11363. Allocation and methodology will be provided after the well is completed. Commingling will not reduce the value of the production. The Bureau of Land Management has been notified in writing of this application.

Proposed perforations are: CH - 4063' - 4088' ; MV - 5024' - 5582' **These perforations are in TVD.**

Interest is common, no notification is necessary.

COPC will use some form of the subtraction method to establish an allocation for commingled wells.
