Contact Mike Flaniken at the address above, or phone 505-564-7702 once the surface disturbance is reclaimed. In addition, we recommend bonding remain in place until the surface rehabilitation is completed and approved.

Such a request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P.O. Procedures governing appeals from the instructions, orders, or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et. Seq
