On July 6, 2016, Animas Environmental Services, LLC (AES) completed an initial release assessment and environmental clearance of the final excavation limits at the ConocoPhillips (COPC) San Juan 28-4 Unit 30E, located in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The release consisted of historic contamination discovered beneath the production tank at the location. The initial release assessment was completed by AES on July 6, 2016, and the final excavation was completed by COPC contractors at the location on the same day.

1.0 Site Information

1.1 Location

1.2 NMOCD Ranking

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) release protocols, action levels were established per NMOCD *Guidelines for Remediation of Leaks, Spills, and Releases* (August 1993) prior to site work. The release was given a ranking score of 10 based on the following factors:

- Depth to Groundwater: Based on elevation, topographic interpretation and visual reconnaissance in addition to a Pit Remediation Report form dated January 2016, the depth to groundwater is reported as greater than 100 feet below ground surface (bgs). (0 points)
- Wellhead Protection Area: The tank location is not within a wellhead protection area. (0 points)
- Distance to Surface Water Body: An unnamed drainage which drains into Vigas Canyon is located approximately 410 feet east of the production tanks. (10 points)

1.3 Assessment

AES was initially contacted by Lisa Hunter of COPC on July 5, 2016, and on July 6, 2016, Sam Glasses of AES completed the release assessment field work. The assessment included collection and field sampling of 14 soil samples from five assessment trenches in and around the release area. Assessment trenches were terminated at approximately 8 feet below grade. Based on field sampling results, AES recommended further excavation of the release area. Sample locations are shown on Figure 3.

On the same day, AES collected confirmation soil samples of the excavation extents. The field sampling activities included collection of five confirmation soil samples (SC-1 through SC-5) from the walls and base of the excavation. The area of the final excavation measured approximately 9.5 feet by 27 feet by 8 feet in depth. Note that the depth of the excavation was limited due to a confining sandstone unit at 8 feet bgs. Sample locations and final excavation extents are presented on Figure 4.

2.0 Soil Sampling

A total of 19 soil samples, including 14 samples from the assessment trenches (TH-1 through TH-5) and 5 composite samples (SC-1 through SC-5), were collected during the assessment and excavation clearance. All soil samples were field screened for volatile organic compounds (VOCs), and selected samples were also analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH). All composite samples (SC-1 through SC-5) collected during the excavation clearance were submitted for confirmation laboratory analysis.

2.1 Field Sampling

2.1.1 Volatile Organic Compounds

Field screening for VOC vapors was conducted with a photo-ionization detector (PID) organic vapor meter (OVM). Before beginning field screening, the PID-OVM was first calibrated with 100 parts per million (ppm) isobutylene gas.

2.1.2 Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons

Field TPH samples were analyzed per U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Method 418.1 using a Buck Scientific Model HC-404 Total Hydrocarbon Analyzer Infrared Spectrometer (Buck). A 3-point calibration was completed prior to conducting soil analyses. Field analytical protocol followed AES's *Standard Operating Procedure: Field Analysis Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons per EPA Method 418.1.*

2.2 Laboratory Analyses

The soil samples collected for laboratory analysis were placed into new, clean, laboratorysupplied containers, which were then labeled, placed on ice, and logged onto a sample chain of custody record. Samples were maintained on ice until delivery to the analytical laboratory, Hall Environmental Analysis Laboratory (Hall) in Albuquerque, New Mexico. All soil samples were laboratory analyzed for:

- Benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylene (BTEX) per USEPA Method 8021B; and
- TPH for gasoline range organics (GRO) and diesel range organics (DRO) per USEPA Method 8015D.

2.3 Field and Laboratory Analytical Results

On July 6, 2016, initial assessment field screening results for VOCs via OVM showed concentrations ranging from 0.0 ppm in TH-2 through TH-5 up to 2,533 ppm in TH-1. Field TPH concentrations ranged from less than 20.0 mg/kg in TH-2 through TH-5 up to 2,650 mg/kg in TH-1.

On the same day, final excavation field screening results for VOCs via OVM ranged from 1.1 ppm in SC-2 up to 434 ppm in SC-5. Field TPH concentrations ranged from 21.4 mg/kg in SC-3 up to 469 mg/kg in SC-5. Results are included below in Table 1 and on Figures 3 and 4. The AES Field Sampling Report is attached.

Laboratory analyses for SC-1 through SC-5 were used to confirm field sampling results from the final excavation. Benzene and total BTEX concentrations were reported below laboratory detection limits in all samples. TPH concentrations as GRO/DRO ranged from below detection limits in SC-2 and SC-3 up to 170 mg/kg in SC-5. Results are presented in Table 2 and on Figure 4. The laboratory analytical report is attached.

3.0 Conclusions and Recommendations

On July 6, 2016, AES conducted an initial assessment of petroleum contaminated soils associated with a historic release of produced water and condensate at the San Juan 28-4 Unit 30E. Action levels for releases are determined by the NMOCD ranking score per *NMOCD Guidelines for Remediation of Leaks, Spills, and Releases* (August 1993), and the site was assigned a rank of 10.

Initial assessment field sampling results above the NMOCD action level of 100 ppm VOCs and 1,000 mg/kg TPH were reported in TH-1. The highest VOC concentration was reported in TH-1 with 2,533 ppm, and the highest TPH concentration was also reported in TH-1 with 2,650 mg/kg. Based on these results, excavation of petroleum contaminated soils was recommended.

On the same day, final excavation of the impacted area was completed. Final excavation dimensions were approximately 9.5 feet by 27 feet by 8 feet in depth. Field sampling results of the excavation extents showed that VOC concentrations exceeded applicable NMOCD action levels for the excavation base, which had a VOC concentration of 434 ppm, but were below NMOCD action levels for the final walls of the excavation, except for SC-4 (west wall) with a VOC concentration of 125 ppm. However, all field TPH concentrations were below the applicable NMOCD action level of 1,000 mg/kg for the final walls and base of the excavation. Laboratory analytical results also reported benzene, total BTEX, and TPH concentrations (as GRO/DRO) below applicable NMOCD action levels in all samples.

Based on final field sampling and laboratory analytical results of the excavation of petroleum contaminated soils at the San Juan 28-4 Unit 30E, VOC, benzene, total BTEX, and TPH concentrations were below applicable NMOCD action levels for each of the sidewalls and base of the excavation. No further work is recommended.
