Sorry for the delay in responding to your e-mails and phone call. We have been working internally to arrive at a solution to your situation.

I have completed a discussion with staff regarding the expired injection authority for the referenced well. In light of HPOC's effort to resume the Entrada production of the Eagle Springs wells, the Division shall allow the use of the disposal well as part of a <u>60-day injectivity test</u>. HPOC will be required to file a notice of intent (Form C-103) with the District III office requesting authority to do so, and receive approval prior to commencing injection. The District will be advised of this allowance.

During the 60-day period, HPOC will be responsible for submitting a new Form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) for the permanent re-instatement of the authority to inject. Please contact the Engineering Bureau staff (Phillip Goetze or Mike McMillan) with any questions on the application process. The injection authorization will expire at the end of the 60-days if no C-108 application has been filed, or if there are regulatory problems associated with re-instating the permit.
