Energen Resources recently finished a pay add and down hole commingling operations on the subject well. In accordance with the approved Notice of Intent dated April 12, 2005 in accordance with Order#R-11363. DHC 1848A

Prior to commingling operations, the Fruitland Coal was producing at a stabilized rate of about 8 MCFPD and about 0 BOPD. The Pictured Cliffs was added in September 23, 2005. The well had stabilized at a rate of about 110 MCPD and about 0 BOPD. The following allocation is recommended (see attached production plot):

Oil Gas 100% **Pictured Cliffs** 90% **Fruitland Coal** 10% N/A
