OCD has received BP work plan on February 13, 2018 OCD approved BP work plan with the following conditions of approval:

- BP will start excavation activities no later than March 23, 2018
- BP will sample the excavation for TPH, BTEX, Benzene and Chlorides
- BP will sample the Bio remediation pile by April 30, 2018 for TPH, BTEX, Benzene and Chlorides
- BP will sample the vadose zone beneath the remediation pile for TPH, BTEX, Benzene and Chlorides.
- BP will schedule with OCD District III for closure confirmation sampling for both the excavation and remediation pile with at least 24 hour notice.
