

1. PRE-RECLAMATION SITE INSPECTION

1.1) A pre-reclamation site inspection with the BLM Farmington Field Office, Environmental Protection Specialist, Bob Switzer and DJR Operating, LLC representative Amy Archuleta on 9-7-16. The P&A Field Inspection Sheet was filled out on location.

2. PROCEDURES

- 2.1) Reclamation work will be completed within one year from plug date. No new disturbance will be allowed outside current disturbed areas. Notification will provide proper authorities via sundry notices, e-mail, or phone. This will be done 48 hours prior to starting dirt work.
- 2.2) All production equipment, concrete slabs, anchors, flowlines (above ground), risers, tanks, debris, and trash will be removed from location and disposed of at the proper facilities.



- 2.3) Top Soil will be stockpiled during reclamation procedures and will be redistributed as needed prior to re-seeding.
- 2.4) Gravel was observed on this location at the time of inspection. The Gravel will be buried on location. Unless lessee would like us to relocate the gravel.
- 2.5) Disturbed areas will be returned (as close as possible), to pre-disturbance topography. The location is flat. No re-contouring will be needed.

- 2.6) The main access road currently goes through a llama farm. We do not plan to reclaim the road, unless otherwise directed.
- 2.7) The soil type is Sandy Loam. The seed mix to be used will be from the Sagebrush Community. We will be using, <u>Fourwing Saltbush</u> (Atriplex canescens) 2.0 PLS/acre <u>Winterfat</u> (Krascheninnikovia lanata) 2.0 PLS/acre, <u>Galleta</u> (Pleuraphis jamesii) 3.0 PLS/acre, <u>Indian</u> <u>Ricegrass</u> (Achnatherum hymenoides) 4.0 PLS/acre, <u>Blue Grama</u> (Bouteloua gracilis) 2.0 PLS/acre, <u>Bottlebrush Squirreltail</u> (Elymus elymoides) 3.0 PLS /acre, <u>Blue flax</u> (Linum lewisii) .25 PLS/acre, <u>Small Flower Globemallow</u> (Sphaeralcea parvifolia) .25 PLS/acre., and. Seed will be distributed via disc type drill.
- 2.8) Fencing, signage, and other deterrents will be installed when necessary to discourage travel on reclaimed areas.

3. WEED MANAGEMENT

3.1) Use of approved pesticide/herbicides shall be according to Federal, State, Tribal, and local laws. Management of invasive and noxious weeds will be eradicated. *No weeds were observed on location*.

4. PIPELINE

4.1) The pipeline will be capped at this location.
