Dear Sir or Madam:

The attached seven (7) sundry notices for extension of Applications for Permit to Drill (APDs) are being rescinded. This letter serves to clarify that the APD's are officially expired and have been terminated pursuant to the release of the bond.

Per Onshore Order 1.III.G.1, an APD approval is valid for 2 years from the date it is approved, or until lease expiration, whichever occurs first. If the operator submits a written request before the expiration of the original approval, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), may extend the APD's validity for up to two (2) additional years. The referenced APDs were approved in 2014, extensions were granted through March 2018 and the Final Abandonment Notices (FANs) were approved between July and October 2018, subsequently releasing the bond and terminating the APDs.

NMOCB AR

Under 43 CFR 3165.3 (b), you may request an Administrative Review of any instructions, orders, or decisions issued by the Authorized Officer. Such a request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, 301 Dinosaur Trail, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87508. Such a request will not result in a suspension of the instructions, orders, or decisions unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from the instructions, orders, or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et. Seq.
