Advanced Wireless Communications, LLC is re-applying for a Temporary Abandoned status for the Dewey 2 gas well in San Juan County for the following reasons:

- 1) This Federal lease continues to be held by production from several other commercially producing wells on the lease.
- 2) Access onto and across this lease is difficult to obtain and the abandonment and loss of any existing infrastructure and access may be difficult to re-acquire.
- 3) As the horizontal Basin Mancos play continues to evolve and move towards the Dewey 2 site, the prospects for renewed activity in the existing wellbore, on the existing well pad and/or within the existing infrastructure are very likely in the near future.
- 4) As a new operator of this well, Advanced Wireless Communications intends to explore potential of this well, well site, and all other potential growth and renewal and request that more time is needed to adequately complete due diligence prior to returning this site to production or pursuing other, less productive options.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

1. The following are conditional requirements to your request to extend the TA status:

The last Mechanical Integrity Test on the subject well was conducted April 4, 2014. Per BLM directives, a well cannot be TA beyond a Five (5) year period of time without conducting and passing a Mechanical Integrity Test (MIT). Since this well's last MIT is beyond the 5 year limit, a new MIT must be conducted within 30 days of the date of this notice. Minimum acceptable test standards will be a charted 500# pressure test with no more than 10 percent pressure drop within a 30 minute test period.

2. Farmington Office is to be notified at least 24 hours prior to conducting MIT operations @ (505) 564-7750.
