Tested PC on 11/21/05 on 3/4" choke for 12 hours for 15 psi and 435 MCF/D. Clean out to 3810'. Land 2-3/8" 4.7# J-55 tubing @ 3599'. Completed as commingled PC/Tertiary gas well. Released rig 11/24/05.
