Plug #2: (Nacimiento Plug) Perforate squeeze holes @ 1780', set CR @ 1730', and squeeze cement outside 5-1/2" casing and fill inside 5-1/2" casing (1780'-1680').

Plug #3: (Surface Plug) Perforate squeeze holes @ 283', circulate cement down 5-1/2" casing and up through bradenhead (283'-0).

1. MIRU. Prepare blow pit. ND wellhead, NU BOP. Kill well with water if necessary.
2. Tally out 2-3/8" tubing.
→ 100' cement plug on CIBP @ 5168'
3. Plug #1 (Ojo Alamo/Kirtland/Fruitland/Pictured Cliffs). Set CIBP at 3397'. Dump bail cement (42 sx) on top of CIBP. TOOH and WOC. Circulate well with water. Pressure test to 500#. If casing does not test, spot subsequent plug as necessary. TOOH.
4. Plug #2: (Nacimiento, 1780'-1680'). Perforate squeeze holes @ 1780'. Set 5-1/2" cement retainer at 1680'. TIH with tubing and sting into retainer. Establish rate into squeeze holes. Mix 51 sx cement, squeeze 35 sx cement outside 5-1/2" casing and leave 16 sx inside casing to cover Nacimiento top. TOH.
5. Plug #3 (Surface plug, 283'-0'). Perforate squeeze holes at 283'. Establish circulation out bradenhead valve. Mix and pump approximately 128 sx down 5-1/2" casing and circulate out bradenhead valve. Shut well in and WOC.
6. ND BOP and cut off casing below surface. Install P&A marker with cement to comply with regulations. RDMO, cut off anchors and restore location.

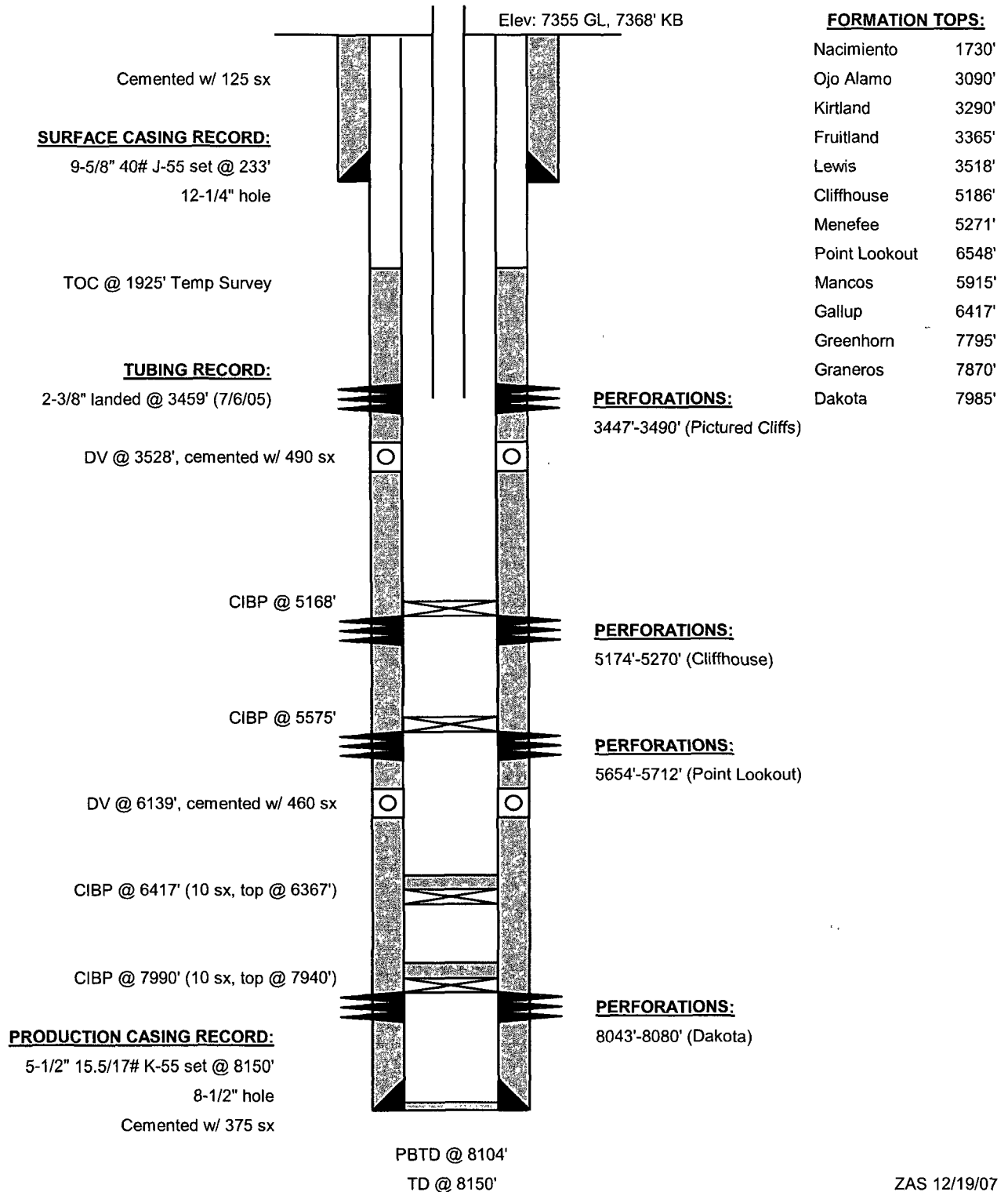

Section 12 T24N R2W

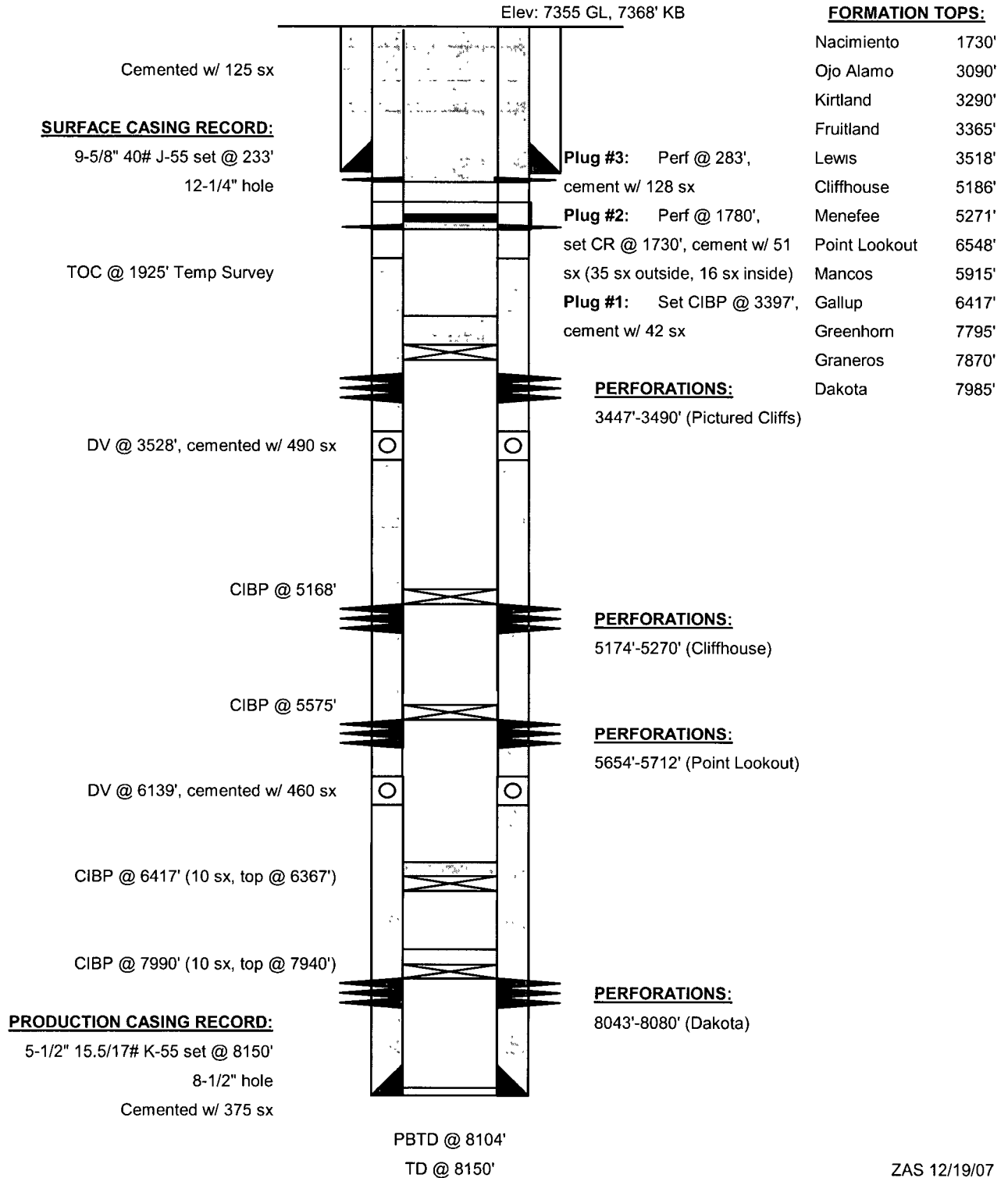
