**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK****FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION**

It is proposed to pull casing in the three wells, known as Santa Fe RR No. 1 and J. Farris Nos. 1 and 2 and plug the wells. Complete logs are not available upon these three wells but there appears to be a 17 to 20 feet sand showing oil and gas at 317-334'. As far as the operator is able to determine there are no other formations requiring protection. It is proposed to cement the oil sand from approximately 315' to 335' and fill the rest of the hole with heavy mud. The standard marker will be cemented at the top of each hole. The attached log covers the Santa Fe RR Lease No. 1 well as far as available and is submitted to be applicable to the other two wells since there are no logs available for the J. Farris No. 1 and No. 2. The operator advised the Commission August 24, 1948, that Santa Fe RR No. 1 was plugged back to 110' and being used for a water well therefore no further plugging will be necessary below 110'. The applicant is receiver of the above company and very few records are available.
